Record enrollment at Ohio State Newark

Enrollment at the Newark campus hit an all-time high this term, with 2,882 students enrolled for autumn semester. This increase marks the fifth consecutive year of rising enrollment at Ohio State Newark and an almost 10 percent increase over autumn semester 2017.
