



The William Allen Kilpatrick Scholarship Application for 2021-2022

The William Allen Kilpatrick Outstanding Student Award was established to provide a non-renewable scholarship to an outstanding **sophomore** student (defined as **30-59 completed credit hours at OSU at the end of spring 2021**) enrolled at the Newark Campus. Interested students must complete the application and submit with a **typed** essay addressing the question: ***“What does leadership mean to me and why is it important?”***

To be considered, interested students must:

- Complete the William Allen Kilpatrick Scholarship Application by **March 15, 2021**.
- Have completed between 30 - 59 credit hours at the end of **spring 2021 while enrolled at OSU**.
- Have been enrolled at least 10 credit hours during most terms enrolled.
- Have a cumulative GPA of at least 3.0 or higher at the end of autumn semester, 2020.
- Be an active member in one or more Newark Campus student organizations or other worthwhile student activities.
- Submit a typed essay addressing the question: ***“What does Leadership mean to me and why is it important?”***
