



The Ohio Means Science (OHMS) Scholarship Program Application for 2022-2023

The Ohio State Newark OHMS Scholars program includes scholarships and student success programming and is made possible by a grant from the National Science Foundation. OHMS invites applications from incoming freshmen majoring in science, technology, engineering, or math. Eligibility is determined based on financial need as established by federal guidelines, academic performance, US citizenship (or eligible non-citizen), declared major, half-time or greater enrollment at Ohio State Newark, and submission of reference letters from at least two STEM teachers and/or mentors with specific knowledge of the applicant. Selection for the OHMS Program is competitive and weighs letters of support over other factors.
