The KBW Scholarship for 2019-2020

The KBW Scholarship was established by the Board of Trustees of the Newark Campus Development Fund through a combined \$2 million gift from Ariel Corporation and Ariel Foundation as part of the Next Generation Challenge Scholarship Campaign. This scholarship is awarded to Knox County residents attending [Central Ohio Technical College](#) and/or [The Ohio State University at Newark](#). Applicants must have demonstrated academic success and financial need. Need is determined by filing the **2019-2020** Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) at www.fafsa.gov.

To be considered, interested students must:

- Complete the KBW Scholarship Application by **March 1, 2019**.
- Plan to enroll in a degree or certificate program at [COTC](#) or [Ohio State Newark](#) in **2019-2020**.
- Be a Knox County resident for at least one year.
- Complete the **2019-2020 FAFSA** at www.fafsa.gov by **March 1, 2019**.
- **NOTE:** Ariel Corporation and Ariel Foundation employees and their children are **not** eligible for the KBW Scholarship.
