


# College Vs. High School

# Types of Disabilities

## ❖ Mental Health

❖ Ex: Depression, Anxiety, ADHD, Autism, PTSD, Bipolar, Mood Disorders, Eating Disorders

## ❖ Learning Disabilities

❖ Ex: Dyslexia, Dysgraphia, Written Expression, Reading, Processing Speed

## ❖ Medical Disabilities

❖ Ex: Diabetes, Crohn's, Migraines, Sleep Disorders, Celiac, Muscular Dystrophy, Epilepsy, Cancer, Tumors, Chronic Nerve Pain, Deaf or Hard of Hearing, Blind or Low Vision

## ❖ Temporary Disabilities

❖ Ex: Concussion, Broken Bone, Post-Surgery



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# Registering With SLDS

- Documentation of a Diagnosed Disability
  - Letter/note from physician, Psychiatrist, etc.
  - Prior History of Accommodations
  - 504/IEP
- Documentation is reviewed
- Students receive an email
- Students contact SLDS to schedule a Welcome Meeting
- Students Receive College Accommodations

# Accommodations and Services

## Accommodations are Individualized

- **Exam Accommodations**

- Extended time, distraction reduced space, computer/word for essay exams, test assistants, assistive technology, large print/braille

- **Attendance Flexibility**

- Includes flexibility in assignment/project deadlines and opportunity for make up exams

- **Note Taking Assistance**

- Instructor notes, recordings, or volunteer note taker

- **Assistive Technology**

- Text to speech, speech to text, screen magnification

- **Accessible Media**

- PDF textbooks, braille, large print, MP3

- **Class/Semester Withdraw**

# Disclosure

- Disability is Confidential
  - Student does NOT have to Disclose Disability
  - Encouraged to share based on Comfort Level
    - Diagnosis/Impact
- FERPA Guidelines
